## Clay's Notes

Mike Mercer designed this pattern as both a nymphal form and an emerger form for Pale Morning Dun, Blue Callibaetis, Trico's, and Green Drakes. Aspects that highlight his pattern are the use of materials to represent gills behind the thorax and the hard shiny epoxy covering of the wingcase.

### Mercers Poxyback Pale Morning Dun Tying Recipe

**Hook:** TMC 200R #16-20  
**Thread:** Danville Orange 6/0  
**Abdomen:** Rust and Light Orange Antron Dubbing  
**Thorax:** Rust and Light Orange Antron Dubbing  
**Back:** Thin Segment of Mottled Oak Turkey Tail  
**Tail:** Three Ringneck Pheasant Tail Fibers  
**Rib:** Pearl Flashabou  
**Gills:** Ginger Marabou  
**Wingcase:** Dark Mottled Oak Turkey tail, epoxied  
**Head:** Rust and Light Orange Antron Dubbing  
**Legs:** Golden Brown Partridge Fibers
