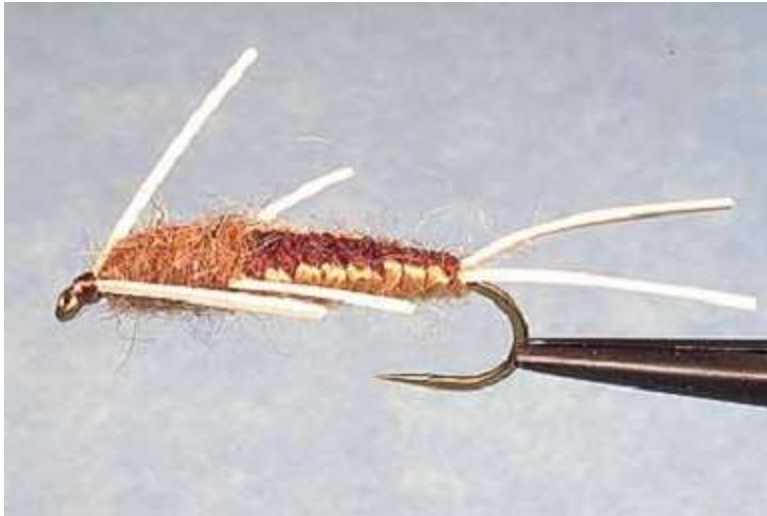


Anderson's Rubberleg Stone



Class: Nymph - Skwala
Matches: Most any stonefly nymph by matching the size and coloration of the natural
Originator: George Anderson

Clay's Notes

This pattern was developed by George Anderson of Yellowstone Anglers. Tie it in yellowish/olive colors with an emphasis on the yellow to match the Skwalas on the Lower Yuba.

Anderson's Rubberleg Stone Tying Recipe

Hook: TMC5263 with weight added
Thread: Olive 6/0
Tail: Tan or Black round rubber leg sections
Abdomen: Yellow/Olive on bottom and medium brown woven synthetic fuzzy yarn on top
Legs: Tan or Black round rubber leg material
Thorax: Yellow/Olive J. Fairs dubbing left shaggy.
