## Clay's Notes

The Bubbleback Emerger is a great pattern for imitating the emerging mayfly. It has a beaded head which adds a slight amount of weight. The bubble back traps air which attract fish. This is an excellent all around pattern that can be tied in a variety of colors to match different mayflies. This is a great addition to your micro mayfly arsenal.

### *The Bubbleback Emerger Tying Recipe – For BWO's*

<b>Hook:</b>	<b>TMC 2487 #16-22</b>
<b>Thread:</b>	<b>Uni-thread Olive 8/0</b>
<b>Bead:</b>	<b>Gold Bead</b>
<b>Tail:</b>	<b>Natural Pheasant tail</b>
<b>Abdomen:</b>	<b>Light Olive Quick Descent Dubbing</b>
<b>Rib:</b>	<b>Small Copper Wire and Olive Krystal flash</b>
<b>Wing Case / Back:</b>	<b>Olive Krystal Flash and Nat. Pheasant tail</b>
<b>Thorax:</b>	<b>Ice Dubbing, Black Peacock</b>
