## Clay's Notes

The Chubby Chernobyl has been a great fly the last couple of years, if not the Top Fly for fishing the Madison or Yellowstone Rivers in Montana. This high floating fly is virtually unsinkable and very easy to see on the water with its high upright wing. The Chubby Chernobyl is a great general searching pattern that can be used to imitate Salmon Flies, Golden Stones, or hoppers depending on size and color. The Chubby also makes an incredible hopper-dropper fly due to its high buoyancy and easy visibility in all types of water. I like to fish this fly in black, tan, brown, pink and green body colors.

<b>Hook:</b>	<b>Dai Riki 730 sz. 8-12. 2x Long</b>
<b>Thread:</b>	<b>UTC Ultra 140 Denier</b>
<b>Dubbing:</b>	<b>SLF Kaufmann Golden Stone or Dave Whitlock Golden Brown</b>
<b>Tail:</b>	<b>Pearl Crystal Flash</b>
<b>Foam:</b>	<b>2mm tan craft foam, or pre-cut foam bodies</b>
<b>Wing:</b>	<b>McFlyon Synthetic white poly</b>
<b>Legs:</b>	<b>Sili Legs</b>
