Clay's Notes

Anything that comes off the creative vise of Rene Harrop works. You could have an entire box with nothing but his patterns. Try Some. If you are every in around the Henrys Fork in Idaho stop by his shop in Last Chance, Truthunters. This pattern works on both rough water and smooth flats. This is a pattern that I would put into a March Brown Specialty "Match the Hatch" Box.

Western March Brown Hairwing Dun

Hook: Standard dry fly, 1x fine, size 12-16
Thread: Tan 6/0 or 8/0
Tails: Brown hackle fibers, split
Body: Cinnamon to tannish-olive fur or synthetic dubbing
Hackle: Brown, 5 turns over thorax, clipped on bottom
Wing: Natural brown deer hair or brown dyed yearling elk
Head: Butts of wing hair
