Clay's Notes

Hogan developed the Isonychia Nymph to match hatches on the Lower Yuba River and the North Fork of the Feather River. He noticed that the nymphs were longer than most nymphs, trimmer and swam very well. His fly is longer, trimmer and the marabou tail give the illusion of swimming. Hogan recommends dead drifting the fly, but swinging it towards the bank prior or through runs prior to the main hatch.
