Hogan Brown Sipper is a great emerger pattern in soft waters. It has been proven to be effective on the Lower Yuba.

Fishing the Sipper

I usually use this pattern as a trailer in the runs, tailouts and eddy pools. I will use a PMD parachute or a PMD Emerger that has a post that I can see and keep track of. The Sipper is trailed about 12" to 14" behind the point fly. If I see a boil or nose poke out of the film I raise the rod tip. The Sipper gets eaten 4 to 1. Add this to your PMD box.
