Clay's Notes

Hogan came up with this Yuba River variation of an X-caddis or an E/C Caddis Tied here in somber shades of tan; an abdomen of Krystal Flash or opalescent mylar might be good for pounding them up. I just like this pattern, it looks buggy and I think if I was a fish I'd eat it. This is a "Must Have" for the Lower Yuba River, if for nothing more than it was named after it. Kidding, it produces! He recommends using it as a caddis emerger/cripple/adult during caddis hatches. He recommends applying floatant to the wing and spun deer hair under body and then drop a Yuba Pupa or a Last Call Caddis with no floatant about 12" to 18" off the back.

Hogan's Yuba Emerger Tying Recipe

Hook:	Dai Riki 320 #16
Thread:	UTC 70 Dark Olive
Shuck:	Congo Hair amber
Abdomen:	Tying thread
Underwing:	CDC tan
Collar/preferred:	Caribou hair
Wing:	Deer hair
