Clay's Notes

Hogan Brown designed the Yuba Pupa to match the caddis hatches on the Lower Yuba River. It is one of my "Go To" patterns. It is designed to swing as an emerger, drift as a pupa under an indicator or dropped off a caddis dry as a dry dropper rig. It can be used any time of the year that fish are looking for caddis pupae. It can be used leading up to, during or after a caddis hatch. This is a guess as to tying materials for the Yuba Pupa.

Yuba Pupa Tying Recipe

Hook: Dai Riki 135 #14
Bead: 7/64 copper
Underbody: Non-tox .015
Thread: Danville 6/0 black
Rib: Small wire copper
Flashback: Medium tinsel pearl
Abdomen: Dark Olive rabbit
Flash: Krystal Flash pearl
Wings/ stubs: Goose biots rusty brown
Shroud: Dark Olive dubbing/Ice Dub
Thorax: Peacock
