## Clay's Notes

Russell Kegler created the Sin City patterns. They are designed to be both an imitative pattern as the profile is slim and of appropriate size and as an attractor with the bright wire abdomen. It is sort of a combination of a Copper John and an imitative mayfly nymph at the same time

### *Sin City – Olive Tying Recipe*

**Hook:** TFS 3769, sizes 12-16  
**Thread:** MFC 8/0 Thread, Black  
**Abdomen:** Small Ultra Wire, Olive  
**Thorax:** Peacock Eyes, natural  
**Head:** Nymph Head Anodized Beads, olive 2.0 mm. – 2.8 mm.  
**Wingcase:** Midge or Small Tyers Glass Bead, Crystal Iridescent  
**Legs:** Midge Flash, pink and pearl  
**Tail:** Bronze Mallard
