**Matches:** Pale Morning Dun (Baetis) emerging nymphs and emergers

## Clay's Notes

A must have pattern to use as an emerging nymph prior to the full, prime time hatch of PMD's. Use this as a dropper behind a visible emerger or dun pattern.

### Quigley's PMD Floating Nymph Tying Recipe

**Hook:** TMC 100, sizes 16-20  
**Thread:** Light olive  
**Tail:** Yellow mallard  
**Rib:** Fine copper wire  
**Abdomen:** Pale yellow Z-lon  
**Wing:** Mixed strands of dun CDC, yellow Z-lon, brown partridge  
**Thorax:** Same as abdomen
