

# Quigley's Loopy Emerger



**Class:** Mayfly Emerger

**Matches:** Most any emerging mayfly, match the size and coloration of the natural

## Clay's Notes

Quigley's Loopy Dun is an effective emerger pattern that can be used in the softer runs, tailouts and eddy pools. I like to rig this fly as a trailing fly to a parachute styled dry. I trail this fly about 12" to 14" behind the point fly. The Loopy is a simple and effective parachute type pattern that rides low in the film.

When fishing this double fly rig I watch the area around the point fly and not the point fly itself. If I see a ripple, a flash or a nose in the vicinity of the point fly. I raise my rod tip. More than not a fish has taken the trailing fly. You can tie this fly to match, BWO's, Pale Morning Duns and Pale Evening Duns on the Lower Yuba River.
