

# Skwalanator



**Class:** Dry - Skwala

**Matches:** Skwala Stonefly Adults

## Clay's Notes

The Skwalanator is designed as a rougher water Skwala where the profile is not as important. It has a dubbed body of yellow dubbing with olive thread to achieve a yellow-olive cast. It is really a prototype fly and I will give it a go this spring when the Skwalas come out.

### Skwalanator Tying Recipe

**Hook:** Tiemco 2312, Size 12 (The Lower Yuba Skwalas are smaller than most patterns in the market)

**Thread:** 8/0 Black

**Egg Sack:** 1/8" black foam cut to 3/32" wide. (Double over and tie about 1/8" past the hook bend.)

**Palmered Hackle:** Black Dry Fly Hackle

**Egg Sack:** Black foam, tying 1/8" past the hook bend.

**Body:** Antron dubbing Yellow, dubbed onto olive thread. .

**Under wing:** Hareline No-Fray Wing Material Black (Fine mesh wing material like micro window screen) Over wing Flash: 5 to six strands of Krystal Flash

**Wing:** Dark Brown Deer Hair - (Sparse Wing)

**Dubbing at Thorax:** Antron dubbing Yellow

**Rubber Legs:** 2 pairs of Tarantula Fine Round Rubber Legs, Brown

**Hackle:** Black Dry Fly Hackle size 14 - That's a lot of materials to fit on that size 12 hook.
