When you take a look at the "Thingamahopper" you must look at it as a "Bobber". A bobber that when a fish looks up at it thinks it's a drowned hopper. It's sort of an indicator in disguise. I have had fish slam it so they definitely get fooled.

You often hear about fishing a "drowned hopper". This pattern floats semi-sunk, especially if you are towing a couple of heavily weighted flies. Some people scoff at it as a novelty, but guess what it works.
