This Yellow Sally Stonefly is a great pattern for wherever you encounter the small stones. Just match the size and coloration of the naturals on the water.

Yellow Sally Stonefly Tying Recipe

Hook: #14-18 Daiichi 1260 or equivalent
Thread: Light cahill 8/0 Uni-Thread
Tails: Stiff pale ginger hackle barbs
Body: Sulphur yellow Superfine dubbing
Wing: Light gold or light yellow Z-Lon and bleached deer hair
Thorax: Sulphur Superfine dubbing
Hackle: Pale ginger in open turns, clipped flat on the bottom
Head: Sulphur yellow Superfine dubbing.
