Clay's Notes

The Yuba Pinkie was a fly first found in the bins of the old Nevada City Fly Shop. I believe they were custom tied using as a variation of a Light Cahill Parachute. They are now available at the Reel Anglers Fly Shop in Grass Valley. They are custom tied to match a particular small mayfly that comes off as is often referred to as a PMD. Is it a PMD or an Epeorus? I'm not an entomologist but I do know this pattern works. Tie it with standard a standard tail and with a split tail. The pattern in the bins have a split tail.

Yuba Pinkie – Tying Instructions

Hook: Mustad 94840 or Tiemco 100
Hook Sizes: 16, 18
Tail: Cream Hackle Fibers
Post: White Calf Tail or Poly
Body: Nature's Spirit – Fine Natural – Pink Cahill #FND 25
Hackle: Cream Hackle
