The Flatulator Tying Recipe

Hook:	TFS 3769, sizes 12-18
Thread:	MFC 8/0 Thread, Dark Olive
Abdomen:	Turkey Biot Quills, BWO
Thorax:	Antron Dubbing, Medium Olive & Rust
Ribbing:	X-Small Ultra Wire, Copper
Head:	Tungsten Bead, copper 5/64"
Wingcase:	Mill Hill Petite Glass Bead
Legs:	Hungarian Partridge, Olive Dyed
Tail:	Hungarian Partridge, Olive Dyed.
