Clay's Notes

Troutbeads have become very popular in Alaska and here in Northern California.

Rigging

(1) Slide the bead onto your tippet

(2) Tie on an egg barbless egg hook, size dependent on the size of the trout or steelhead you're targeting.

(3) Buy some cocktail toothpicks, Cut 1/8" of the pointed end, and Insert it into the hole of the bead facing the hook.

(4) Cut off the toothpick to the length that when you pinch it into the hole with your forceps, it will completely fill the hole.

(5) Move the bead back towards the eye of the hook and leave about 1/2" to 3/4" at the most of tippet between the eye of the hook and the bead.
