## **Clay's Notes**

This fly reminds me a lot of the Lafontaine Pupa. It has that transparency that the fish just seem to like. It's a go to fly below the riffles in the spring for me.

Hogan states that the Yuba Pupa is the best and most versatile caddis pupa he has come up with yet. He recommends fishing this under indicator prior to the caddis hatch and then as the hatch approaches he likes to swing it at the bottom of the riffles to imitate pupa moving to the surface. Once the hatch is it full gear he likes to fish it about 18" behind a Yuba Emerger to imitate the pupa stuck in the film or struggling to the surface.
