Clay's Notes

Troutbeads have become very popular in Alaska and here in Northern California.

Rigging

- (1) Slide the bead onto your tippet
- (2) Tie on an egg barbless egg hook, size dependent on the size of the trout or steelhead you're targeting.
- (3) Buy some cocktail toothpicks, Cut 1/8" of the pointed end, and Insert it into the hole of the bead facing the hook.
- (4) Cut off the toothpick to the length that when you pinch it into the hole with your forceps, it will completely fill the hole.
- (5) Move the bead back towards the eye of the hook and leave about 1/2" to 3/4" at the most of tippet between the eye of the hook and the bead.
