The Copper John created by John Barr is a fly that belongs in every fly box. It falls into the category of an "Attractor" to me. I carry them in Red, Green, Copper, Black, and Blue. I carry sizes 14-18. The Red Copper Job is often a day saver on the Lower Yuba.

Copper John Tying Recipe

Hook: TMC 5262 #12-18
Thread: 70 Denier, Black
Bead: Gold colored Brass or Tungsten, sized to hook.
Tail: Dark Brown Goose Biot
Body: Wapsi UTC Wire, Color of Choice, sized to hook.
Flashback: Pearl Flashabou
Wingcase: Black Thinskin
Thorax: Peacock Herl
Legs: Hungarian Partridge
Wingcase Coating: 5 Minute Epoxy
