## Clay's Notes

This fly is a no nonsense "Wulff" type fly for more bouncy water. Having a variety of imitations can be key to a successful day on the water. On some days fish want a high floating traditional, on others they want a pattern that sits low to the water and more closely resembles the struggling emerging adult.

### *Para Wulff Tying Recipe*

<b>Hook:</b>	<b>TMC 100SP-BL #12-18</b>
<b>Thread:</b>	<b>TMC 16/0 White</b>
<b>Wing:</b>	<b>White Calf Body Hair</b>
<b>Tail:</b>	<b>Moose Hock Rib: Pearl Krystal Flash</b>
<b>Abdomen:</b>	<b>Purple Dubbing of your choice</b>
<b>Hackle:</b>	<b>Brown and Grizzly Rooster neck or saddle</b>
<b>Thorax:</b>	<b>Same Dubbing as abdomen</b>
