## Clay's Notes

I don't have a recipe for this Baetis Nymph that is from Solitude Flies. It is tied on a curved shank hook, uses an olive biot for the body, looks like some buggy fibers, a few hackle fibers and a shiny wingcase. So, let's see, all attributes for a killer pattern. His pattern can be used from near the bottom when using a rig with shot or in the top inch. Versatile. This one is also tied in a slender style which fussy fish seem to prefer.
