| Hook:   | 900BL, sizes 16-20                  |
|---------|-------------------------------------|
| Thread: | Olive                               |
| Wing:   | Mallard flank, tied parachute style |
| Tail:   | Two blue dun Micro Fibbets, split   |
| Body:   | Olive Haretron or Superfine         |
| Hackle: | Natural or olive-dyed grizzly       |
