John Barr's Hopper Dropper is a pattern to use in the summer when you decide to use a "Hopper-Dropper" rig. That is a big buoyant fly that has one or two nymphs suspended below it. This is a pattern that will stay floating with weighted flies towed below. Try this method when searching for aggressive trout.

You can think about Barr's Hopper Dropper as a "Bobber". Hand one or two nymphs underneath and just keep your eyes on the hopper. If it twitches, set!
