Hook: MFC 2XL 7026, Bronze
Thread: Uni-Thread, Tan
Abdomen: MFC Frog's Hair, Light Cahill
Antennae: Goose Biot, Brown
Back: MFC Swisher's Gator Hair, Burnt Orange
Bead: MFC Brass Bead, Gold
Legs: Hungarian Partridge Loose Feathers, Natural
Rib: Wire, Copper
Tail: Goose Biot, Brown
Thorax: Wings-n-Flash, Yellow
Wingcase: Trash Bag, Black
