## Brite Rock Worm Tying Recipe

Hook:	TMC 2457 # 10-#16, Mustad CO68, #10-#16
Thread:	Gordon Griffith 14/0 Sheer, Black – for deer collartied first
Under/ Abdomen:	UTC thread, 70 Denier, Black
Over/ Abdomen:	UTC HOLO Tinsel Medium, Silver
Wrap:	Hareline Edge Brite, Fl. Green. thin strip
Rib:	Lagartun, oval silk core, X-fine, Silver
Thorax:	Black Ostrich Herl
Rib:	Lagartun, oval silk core, X-fine, Silver
Bead:	Gold or Black, appropriate size for hook
Collar/ hackle:	Dyed Black Coastal Deer Hair
