## **Clay's Notes**

Late in the evening using a CDC Spinner PMD can produce trailed behind something you can actually see like a PMD parachute. The double dry rig really helps as the sun goes down when you have no chance of seeing the spinner. Keep tabs of the parachute pattern as it drifts and watch for any movement, bulge or flash and set when you get that feeling that something is happening. Trust your instincts and you may have "Fish On"!

## CDC Spinner (PMD)

Hook: Tiemco TMC100 or equivalent, sizes 12 to 20.

Thread: Light cahill 8/0 (70 denier).

Wings: Nature's Spirit Cahill CDC Oiler Puffs

Tail: White Betts Tailing Fibers.

Abdomen: Tying thread. Hackle: Light ginger.
