## Clay's Notes

A thorax styled Dun pattern can work well on the Lower Yuba River when the "Pinkies" are floating on the surface film. You can use this Pale Morning Dun Thorax recipe and change it up a bit to match the local hatch.

The CDC Thorax Pink Albert as tied by Rene Harrop is available at fly shops that carry Solitude Flies.

### *Pale Morning Dun Thorax Recipe (Variation): Designer - Mike Lawson*

**Hook:** TMC100 sizes 16-20  
**Thread:** Pale olive 6/0  
**Wing-** Medium gray turkey flat  
**Tail:** Light dun hackle barbs  
**Body:** Pale yellow-olive Antron dubbing  
**Hackle:** Light dun wound collar style clipped at bottom
