Clay's Notes

A Cahill Pattern can be used to match the "Pinkies" on the Lower Yuba. The color needs to match the local bug. It is sort of tan with a very slight pink tint. You just have to experiment a bit with the dubbing. This is a hackled dry type tie and you should trim the hackle on the underside to keep the fly floating flush in the film.

CAHILL (LIGHT COLOR SCHEME) PATTERN RECIPE:

Hook: TMC100 sizes 12-20
Thread: Cream 6/0
Wings: Wood duck flank fibers tied upright and separated
Tail: Light ginger hackle barbs
Body: Natural muskrat fur dubbing (Custom blend to Tan with a bit of Pink)
Hackle: Light ginger wrapped collar style.
