Clay's Notes

The second generation of the all-time best Yellowstone hopper has proven to be a powerhouse pattern in its own right. Modifications from the original Chaos Hopper include an easier to cast foam bullethead and a highly visible foam indicator

Chaos Hopper Tying Recipe

Hook: Dai-Riki #280 sizes 10-14

Thread: UTC Ultra 140 or 70 Denier brown thread.

Foam: 2mm cocoa craft foam.

Wing: Tan Crinkled Z-Lon

Legs: Square rubber legs from Blue Ribbon Fly Shop sold in tan, yellow and green. Pattern looks pretty good with med. round legs also.

Post: 2mm orange or yellow foam.

Note: You can use the UTC 140 denier for the larger size foam hopper patterns, and the 70 denier for any foam pattern size 14 and smaller.
