The Chernobyl Ant is a great hopper and attractor pattern. The Chernobyl Ant is made of primarily foam, so the fly floats like a cork! The Chernobyl Ant is best used in the heat of summer, when grasshoppers and terrestrials are most active. The Chernobyl Ant can be tied in many different colors. Tan, Olive and Yellow are the most common and effective. The Chernobyl Ant is tied large. #06-10 are the best sizes to use.

Chernobyl Ant Tying Recipe

Hook: TFS 300, sizes 6-10

Thread: MFC 6/0Tying Thread, match to color

Body: 2mm Fly Foam, choose your colors of choice and layer

Ribbing: MFC 6/0 Tying Thread, match to color Legs: Round Rubber Legs, match to color Post: 2mm Fly Foam, Color of choice
