| Hook: | Dai Riki 305 #14 (18) |
|--------------------|----------------------------|
| Thread: | MFC 8/0 Sand (Olive) |
| Tail: | Grizzly hackle fibers |
| Abdomen: | Goose biot (Olive) |
| Underwing/wingpad: | CDC dark dun |
| Thorax: | Hare's ear dubbing (Olive) |
| Overwing: | Guinea |
