

# Epeorus Spinner



**Class:** Mayfly Spinner

**Matches:** Epeorus "Pinkie" and some PMD Spinners

## Clay's Notes

This spinner pattern is a simple tie using White Zelon for the spent wings. A spinner can work well on the flats and quite runs in the evenings. Trail the spinner about 12" to 14" from a dry or emerger pattern that has a post you can see. If anything moves, flashes, bulges in the vicinity of the flies raise the rod tip.

### *Epeorus Spinner Tying Recipe*

**Hook:** TMC 900BL, #16 – #18  
**Thread:** Gordon Griffiths 14/0, Sheer. Brown  
**Tail:** White Hackle fibers  
**Rib:** Strand of tying thread  
**Body:** Superfine Rusty Brown #051 mixed with #176 Hendrickson Pink (1-3)  
**Wings:** White Zelon
