
## **Epeorus Spinner**

## **Clay's Notes**

This spinner pattern is a simple tie using White Zelon for the spent wings. A spinner can work well on the flats and quite runs in the evenings. Trail the spinner about 12" to 14" from a dry or emerger pattern that has a post you can see. If anything moves, flashes, bulges in the vicinity of the flies raise the rod tip.

## **Epeorus Spinner Tying Recipe**

Hook: TMC 900BL, #16 – #18

Thread: Gordon Griffiths 14/0, Sheer. Brown

Tail: White Hackle fibers
Rib: Strand of tying thread

Body: Superfine Rusty Brown #051 mixed with #176 Hendrickson Pink (1-3)

Wings: White Zelon
