Clay's Notes

This is yet again another Rene Harrop creation. It incorporates CDC fibers for the wing and a biot body. This is a good combination.

Sometimes all it takes is something to differentiate your fly from the rest, especially while fishing a Caddis Hatch. CDC is one of these different things. The Fertile Caddis is one that can be used as a dropper fly. I have fished it behind a size #14 hi-vis caddis pattern. While the two fly rig can be very successful, I also like fishing this fly by itself when sight fishing to selective trout.
