Henry's Fork Caddis Tying Recipe

Hook:	Tiemco 102Y #15
Thread:	Benecchi 12/0, black
Hackle:	Grizzly, dyed dun
Thorax:	Peacock herl
Abdomen:	Goose biot, dyed olive
Wing:	CDC, natural; Hungarian Partridge back feather barbs
