

# Hogan's Spring Fling Pupa

## Clay's Notes

**If I'm fishing a Mother's Day Caddis hatch, here in Northern California or in Montana, I'll either have a Fox's Springtime Pupa pattern tied on or Hogan's Spring Fling Pupa. Hogan's Spring Fling Pupa has a place reserved in my fly box.**

**It can be fished deep as a nymph or high in the water column as an emerger. Hogan recommends it as a general attractor or swung as an emerger. It can be fished in the surface as an emerger or a cripple when caddis are up in the water column. I would recommend this as a must have pattern. They're in my "Lower Yuba Fly Box". It was developed right here on the Lower Yuba, that's good enough for me. Make sure you have these in your box!**

**\*Use it For\* - Mother's Day Caddis and for Spring Caddis on the Lower Sacramento River and the Lower Yuba, as an imitative Spring Caddis nymph or in the spring as a general attractor!**
