### Jacklin's Green Rock Worm Tying Recipe

**Hook:** Dai-Riki #135 Scud Hook Sizes 12, 14, 16, 18  
**Thread:** Black, 6/0  
**Body:** Chartreuse dubbing  
**Ribbing:** Chartreuse Vinyl Rib  
**Head:** Glass or Tungsten bead  
**Legs:** Peacock Hurl tied tight and sparse at the head
