Clay's Notes

The Pink Albert is a floating nymph pattern that can be used in tandem with a dry fly "Pinkie". I use a two fly rig when a Pale Morning Dun hatch is in progress. I typically use a parachute styled dry with a tan/pink body to match our local PMD's and then trail the Pink Albert nymph tied in the same colors behind the dry about 12" to 14". I typically present this pattern across and slightly downstream or downstream.

It is a simple fly to tie using simple materials.
