Clay's Notes

The Pheasant Tail Nymph was created by Frank Sawyer and can be used to imitate a wide variety of mayflies, including BWO's (Sizes18-20), PMD's (Sizes16-18) and March Brown's (Size 14). Everyone should carry rows of these nymphs in the various sizes.

Pheasant Tail Nymph Tying Recipe

Hook: 2X-long nymph hook (here, a Daiichi 730), sizes 12-20.

Thread: Brown, 6/0 or 70 denier. Rib: Copper Ultra Wire, small.

Tail and abdomen: Dark brown pheasant tail fibers.

Legs and Wingcase: Dark brown pheasant tail fibers.

Thorax: Peacock herl. Head: Brown thread. Adhesives: Head cement.
