The Prince nymph is a proven attractor nymph and is often overlooked. I was fishing the Lower Sacramento River one day and a Fly Shop Guide was on fire. I talked to him he said use anything with peacock herl. The Mother Day Caddis hatch was just starting after everyone getting excited and waiting for a couple of weeks. It wasn't fully on, just starting. I looked in my fly box and I had a row of Prince Nymphs. I tied one on and we started lighting it up too! They've earned a spot in my "General Nymph Box" which I take everywhere!

Prince Nymph Tying Recipe

Hook: TMC 3761, sizes 10-16
Thread: Danville Black 6/0
Tail: Brown turkey or Goose biots
Rib: Fine Gold flat tinsel
Underbody: Black Rabbit Dubbing
Body: Peacock Herl
Legs: Brown Hen Cape Hackle or Partridge
Wing: White turkey or Goose biots
