Quigley's PMD Floating Nymph Tying Recipe

Hook:	TMC 100, sizes 16-20
Thread:	Light olive
Tail:	Yellow mallard
Rib:	Fine copper wire
Abdomen:	Pale yellow Z-lon
Wing:	Mixed strands of dun CDC, yellow Z-lon, brown partridge
Thorax:	Same as abdomen
