Clay's Notes

Bob Quigley developed the Sparkle Stacker to achieve a different profile for fussy trout. It sits lower in the surface than a traditional parachute and provides a fantastic silhouette. The sparkle shuck and body provide a little more attention in the feeding frenzy.

Sparkle Stacker – Pale Evening Dun Tying Recipe

Hook: Daiichi 110, sizes 16-20
Thread: MFC 8/0 Tying Thread – Cream
Shuck: Antron Yarn, White
Abdomen: MFC 8/0 Tying Thread – Cream
Wing: Antron Yarn – White
Thorax: Super Fine Dry Fly Dubbing: Pale Evening Dun
Twist Thread: Fine Mono
Hackle: Medium Dun
