The Skips nymph is a great pattern for you to tie yourself. You can use the Skip Nymph anywhere that you would use a Pheasant Tail Nymph. Tie some up.

Skip's Nymph Tying Recipe

Hook:	Standard or 1X long nymph or larva hook, #6-22
Thread:	Match color to dubbing 6/0.
Tail:	Natural, rust, olive, gold, or black dyed pheasant tail fibers (extend tail material for shellback)
Rib:	Fine gold or copper wire
Abdomen:	Tan, olive, black, or brown or yellow dubbing to match natural nymph's belly color
Wingcase:	Pheasant tail fibers to match tail
Thorax:	Slightly darker dubbing than abdomen.
