Clay's Notes

Bill Carnazzo developed this Twilight Pinkie to match the small and slender mayflies that are a "Pinkish Tan". This coloration adapted to the Lower Yuba River has become one of the best producers during a PMD hatch. The Lower Yuba PMD's/Eperous mayflies have that in-between coloration. Keep playing with the dubbing mix until you get good results. From the trout that is.

Twilight Pinkie Tying Recipe

Hook:	Tiemco 100, Or 900BL, or similar dry fly hook, #16 or 18
Thread:	Dun 8/0
Tail:	Light Dun Microfibbets
Abdomen:	75% Light Pink dubbing, 25% Light Tan dubbing, very fine in texture. Adapted to the Lower Yuba mayflies
Ribbing:	Fine gold wire
Hackle:	Light Dun Neck or saddle hackle
Wing:	Light dun turkey flats
Thorax:	Same as abdomen
