## Clay's Notes

Almost every fly fisher has some Flashback Pheasant Tail Nymphs in their box. If you don't take a hint. These "Attractor" nymphs always seem to produce where Baetis and PMD's live. They have a little flash that can make a fish eat sometimes.

### Gold Bead Flashback Pheasant Tail Recipe

**Hook:** TMC 5262 #12-18  
**Thread:** 8/0 UNI Rusty Brown  
**Bead:** Brass, Copper or Tungsten, sized to hook  
**Weight:** Lead wire, sized to hook  
**Tail:** Ringneck Pheasant Tail Fibers  
**Rib:** Fine Copper wire  
**Abdomen:** Ringneck Pheasant Tail Fibers  
**Wingcase:** Ringneck Pheasant Tail Fibers topped with Firefly Flash  
**Thorax:** Peacock herl  
**Legs:** Leftover butts of Pheasant tail from wingcase
