Almost every fly fisher has some Flashback Pheasant Tail Nymphs in their box. If you don't take a hint. These "Attractor" nymphs always seem to produce where Baetis and PMD's live. They have a little flash that can make a fish eat sometimes.

Gold Bead Flashback Pheasant Tail Recipe

Hook:	TMC 5262 #12-18
Thread:	8/0 UNI Rusty Brown
Bead:	Brass, Copper or Tungsten, sized to hook
Weight:	Lead wire, sized to hook
Tail:	Ringneck Pheasant Tail Fibers
Rib:	Fine Copper wire
Abdomen:	Ringneck Pheasant Tail Fibers
Wingcase:	Ringneck Pheasant Tail Fibers topped with Firefly Flash
Thorax:	Peacock herl
Legs:	Leftover butts of Pheasant tail from wingcase
