Clay's Notes

The *Mercer's Tungsten Swing Caddis* is both a great nymphing and swing caddis emerger pattern. The Mercer's Tungsten Swing Caddis has a Tungsten Bead integrated into the thorax. This bead adds a lot of weight to the pattern, while still keeping the buggy profile. The CDC in the fly will retain small air bubbles, just like a emerging caddis pupa. The Ice Dub hides the Tungsten Bead in the thorax and also adds a hint of flash to the fly. All in all, the Mercer's Tungsten Swing Caddis is a very versatile caddis pattern!

Hook:	#12-16 <u>Tiemco</u> 3761
Bead:	Black Tungsten Bead
Thread:	White and Black UTC 70
Body:	Olive Midge Tubing
Rear Collar:	Brown CDC
Thorax:	Pheasant Tail Ice Dub Dubbing
Front Collar:	Good Partridge
